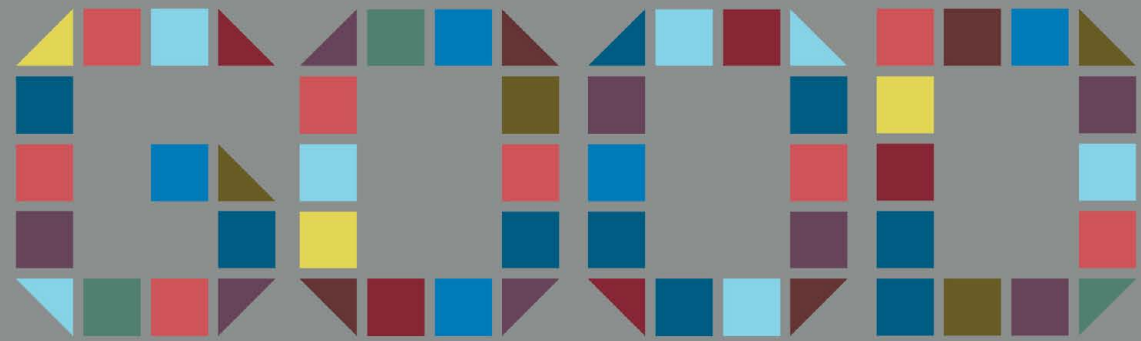

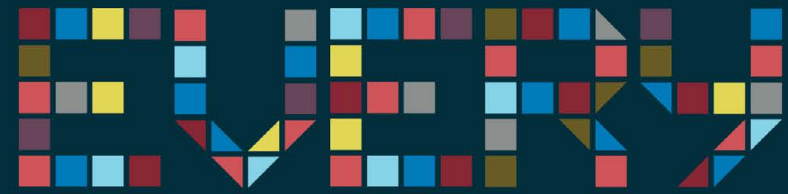

The cost of a TCS education reflects the exciting learning environment, our supportive community, and our innovative approach to education.

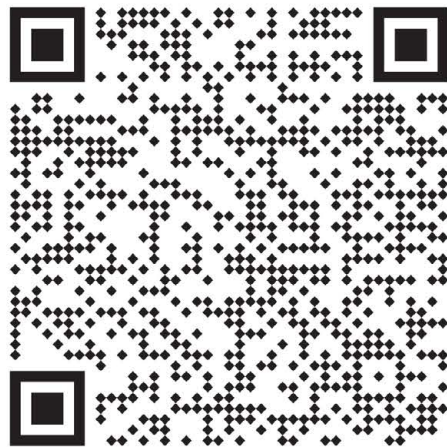
Students and families often describe the TCS experience as priceless, but we know that the financial commitment is beyond some families' capabilities.
